



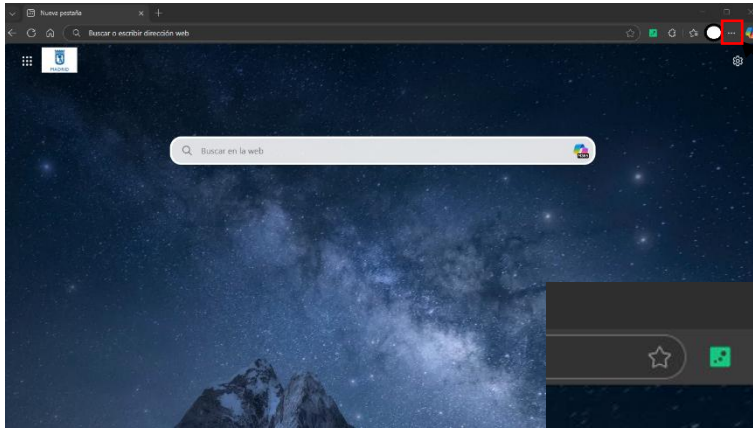

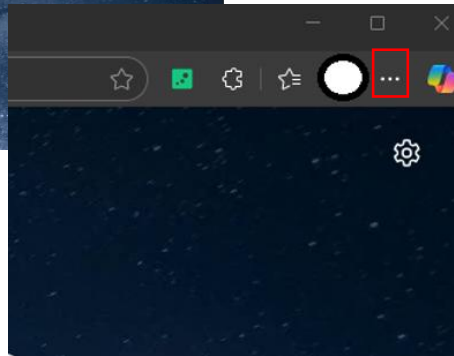

## Access your browser settings

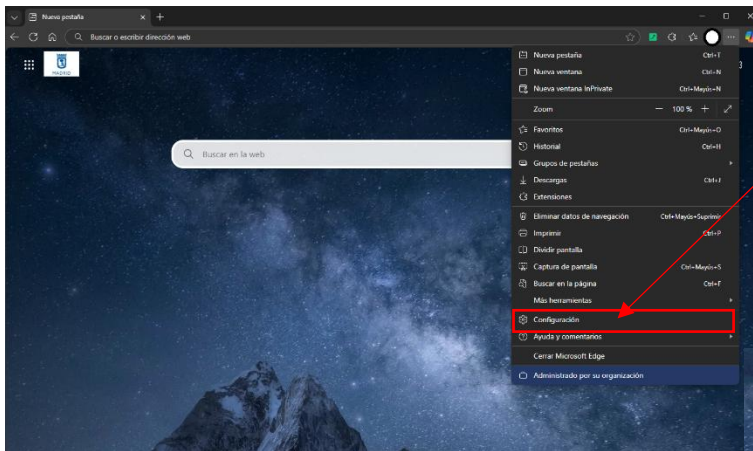
In the upper right corner, locate the three dots that give access to the browser's options menu.



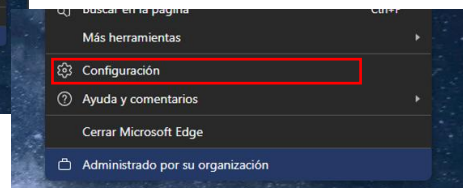
Tap on the three dots in the upper right corner of the browser



Click on "Settings" when the options menu drops.

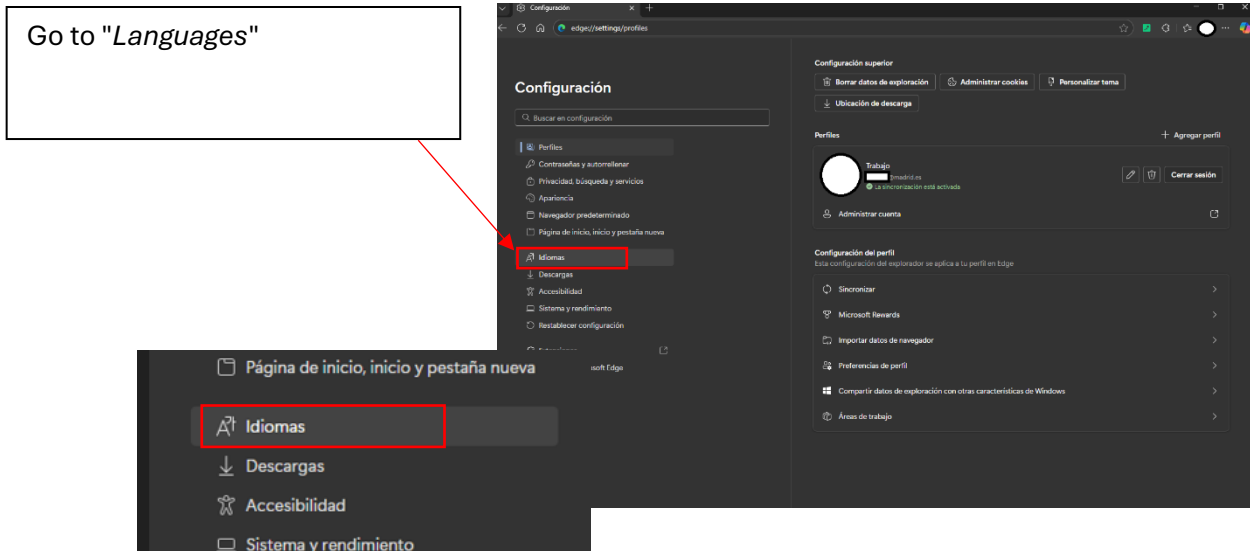


Go to "Settings"



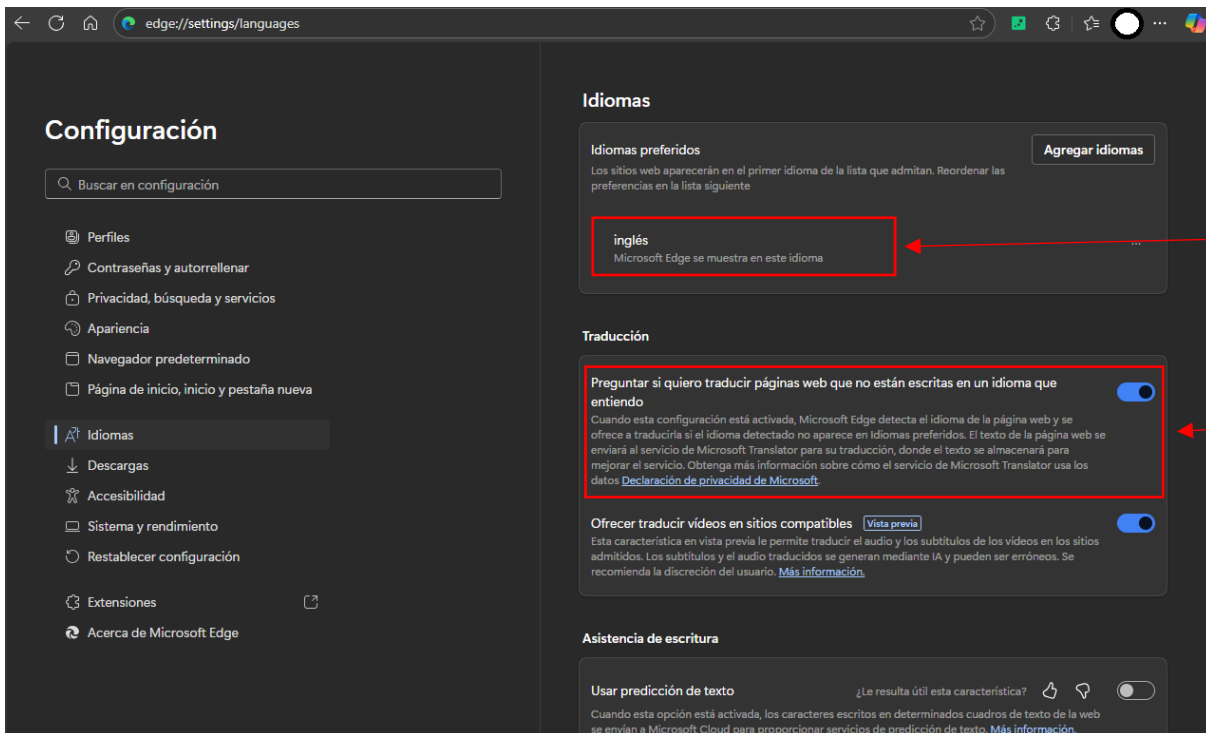
# Enable Edge Translator

Click on the "Languages" option in the options on the left side of the browser.



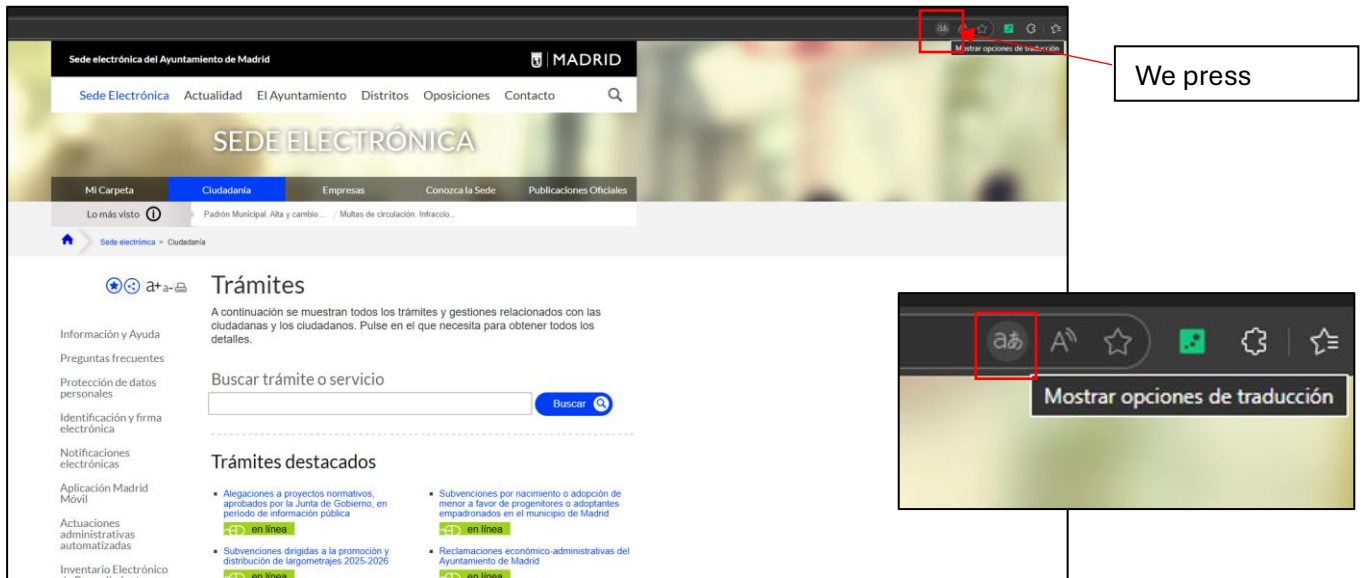
Configure the following options:

- In the "Preferred Languages" section, add the language "English" as seen in the image. You can choose the English of a particular area, such as "English (United States)" or "English (United Kingdom)".
- in the "Translation" section, if it is not enabled, turn on the option "Ask if I want to translate web pages that are not written in a language I understand".

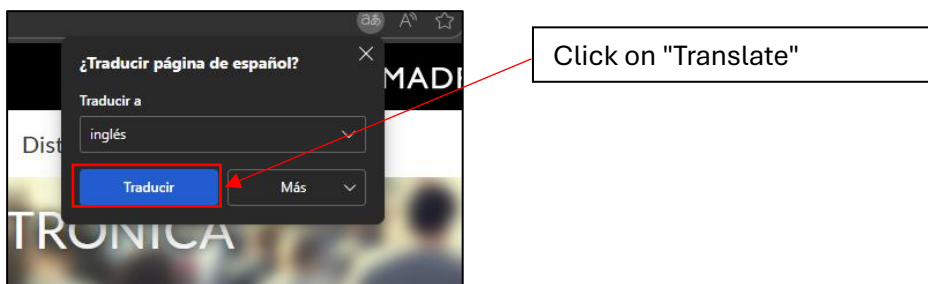


## Check the translation

Enter the electronic office and check that in the address bar there is the option to translate the page, click on the icon:



Click "Translate" in the pop-up menu that appears to translate the page.



The electronic office will appear translated into the selected language.
